

In March, work commenced . . .

Kitchen vegetable/herb garden

- Becky Blake managed
- •Purchased heritage seeds and plants from Monticello to plant
- •Seasonal vegetables planted throughout spring, summer and fall
- Scotchtown staff person assisted with maintenance and planting

Compost bin constructed

- •Jane White, along with husband, Bobby, purchased materials
- •Jane and Doris constructed the bin April 9 and placed it by fence near formal gardens
- •All plant material will go into the bin and, when seasoned, will be placed on the vegetable garden

Formal gardens work

- •Removed two Japanese hollies in July
- Thinned day lilies, donated to Scotchtown staff
- •In November, replanted butterfly weed, installed two native hydrangeas where hollies had been
- •In December, final cleanup and spreading pine tag mulch


