

Immediate Past President – Position Description

Overview

The Immediate Past President is a member of the Board of Directors. One of the main duties is to chair the Nomination Committee for elected positions for the next year.

Qualifications

- Any candidate for the position of Immediate Past President must be a member in good standing. Good standing includes:
 - Dues paid
 - At least 8 hours of continuing education
 - At least 20 hours of public education from project categories of ES, YH and QL
 - Passed background check
- Served as President for at least one year

Job Duties

- Chair the Nominations Committee to find candidates for the elected positions for the next year
- Attend Board Meetings
- Share knowledge and lessons learned as requested
- Review By-Laws to determine if any changes are needed
- Possibility of additional duties as appropriate to position of Immediate Past President
