

Plant Sale Report 2019

Our annual plant sale was held on April 27th. It was a cool brisk day and at time tents and other loose objects were a challenge. We only had two vendors due to so many other events going on at the same time.

We had a potting party at Pat's house on March 30th for those plants that needed to be potted ahead of time. Pat took charge of those plants and kept them watered until the day of the sale. As always one of the highlights of the potting party is our pot luck lunch in Pat's backyard.

On Friday night we checked in the plants that people had previously potted at home. It was cold and rainy but we just set up under the porch at the church and added price tags to the plants. People also donated garden type items for our "Garden Shop" which we priced that night.

Saturday morning was the usual flurry of getting set up. Ed brought about 500 tomatoes and some herbs. Another of our popular items has been the mushroom compost. We had doubled the quantity this year and still sold out by noon. Multiple members brought snacks to keep us well fed during the day.

Our left over plants were donated to Immanuel Church in Old Church for their event the following weekend.

We estimate that we had about 500 visitors to our plant sale. Our profit for this year was about \$3,400.
